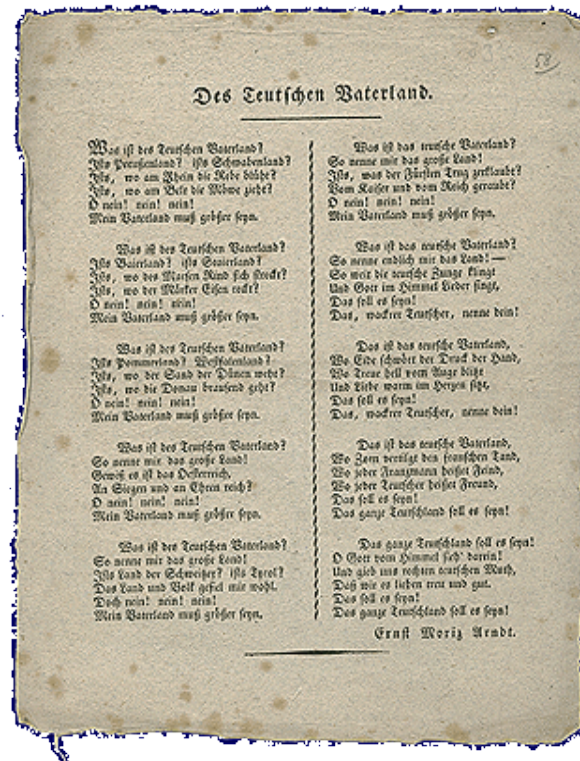


Revision: Nationalism in “Germany” in the late 18th and early 19th Centuries

TASKS:

- Together, revise what characterizes German nationalism in the late 18th and early 19th centuries (remember: from “internal” to “external” nationalism?). Use the Advance Organizer for help.
- Revise and summarize the message of Ernst Moritz Arndt’s 1813 song “Was ist des Deutschen Vaterland?”.
- Put the source into its historical context and explain the peculiarities of German nationalism in the time up to the 1848/9 Revolutions.
- Against the backdrop of your results, discuss whether Arndt was a demagogue or a democrat.

- ▶ Describe the postcard of the Pan-German League and discuss to what extent it is representative for nationalism in the time of imperialism.
- ▶ Explain the peculiarities of German imperialism with reference to the given source.
- ▶ Discuss to what extent nationalism in the time of New Imperialism contributed to the outbreak of WWI.
